NOTICE PURSUANT TO ART. 13 GDPR FOR MEMBERS AND PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS AND CONSENT TO PROCESSING

Dear member or prospective member,

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679 on the protection of personal data (“GDPR”), we inform you of the following:

Purposes of Processing and Legal Basis

The Association processes your personal data exclusively to carry out its institutional activities, specifically:

- a) to manage the membership relationship (sending correspondence, calling meetings, handling internal administrative procedures) and to organize and execute the activities of the Association;
- b) to fulfill any legal obligations (e.g., tax, insurance, etc.) related to the Association's members;
- c) to send communications related to the activities and initiatives of the Association via mail, email, newsletter, phone, or other electronic means;
- d) regarding images/videos, to publish them on the Association’s website, social media, newsletters, or printed promotional materials related to the Association’s institutional activities, subject to explicit consent;
- e) to facilitate members' participation in courses, meetings, and initiatives and to organize and manage such events;
- f) for statistical analyses, including aggregated data.

The legal basis for processing is the request for membership and the membership agreement (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR), consent to processing (Art. 6(1)(a) and Art. 9(2)(a) GDPR), regular contact with the Association (Art. 9(2)(d) GDPR), and legal obligations binding on the Association (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR).

Methods and Principles of Processing

Processing will comply with GDPR and Legislative Decree No. 196/03 (“Personal Data Protection Code”), as well as principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, adequacy, and relevance. It will be conducted using both paper and electronic means by persons authorized by the Association and with appropriate protective measures to ensure the security and confidentiality of the data. No automated decision-making processes will be used.

Necessity of Providing Data

Providing personal and contact data is necessary as it is closely related to the management of the membership relationship. Consent for the use of images/videos and dissemination of data through institutional channels is optional.

Data Communication and International Transfers

Data may be disclosed to parties responsible for activities mandated by legal obligations (e.g., accountants, insurers, IT administrators) and to individuals or entities, public or private, where communication is necessary or functional to institutional activities (e.g., trainers, local authorities, IT maintenance companies, course organizers). Where necessary or appropriate, recipients of data performing activities on behalf of the Association will be designated as external Data Processors pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR.

Data Retention Period

Data will be used by the Association until the membership relationship ends. After that, data will be retained for archival purposes, legal, accounting, or tax obligations, or for protecting the Association's interests, excluding communication to third parties, and always in compliance with principles of proportionality and data minimization.

Rights of the Data Subject

As a data subject, you are guaranteed all rights specified in Articles 15–20 GDPR, including the rights to access, rectify, and erase data, to restrict and object to processing, and to withdraw consent (without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on prior consent), as well as to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority if you believe that processing violates GDPR or Italian law. These rights can be exercised via written communication sent by email, certified email, fax, or registered mail to the Association's headquarters.
